

- A Love Apple Farm** 1421 State Route 9H, Ghent 518-828-5048 www.loveapplefarm.com
Part of the Ghent community and regional farm scene since 1969. 80 acres of over 25 varieties of apples and fruits. Farmers Market boasts 4500 sq. ft. offering tree ripe fruits, fresh bread, cheeses, dairy and meats. Cafe serves up Mexican and American fare, fresh baked apple cider donuts and pastries. Stroll our grounds, free petting zoo, playground and Love Apple's Art Space. Open all year round—7 days a week.
- B Grimaldi Farm** 22 Old Talerico Road, Ghent 518-929-3420
We raise Certified Organic grass-fed and grass-finished beef and rotational raised non-GMO fed chickens. Farm Store sells Certified Organic grass-fed beef, farm fresh eggs, along with many other local products. Self-guided tours from 10 am–4 pm.
- C Hudson-Chatham Winery** 1900 State Route 66, Ghent 518-392-9463
Columbia County's first winery established by the DeVito family in 2007. 4.5 acres of vineyards yield over 9 tons of varieties of French-American hybrid grapes. We produce dry, sweet and dessert wines, including Solera-aged sherry-style wines. Offering locally produced spirits, beers, and foods in its tasting room, and hosting special events throughout the year. Voted the Capital Region's and Columbia County's *Best Local Winery* for multiple years. Open Wed. thru Sun. year-round for tastings.
- D Maple Leaf Sugaring** 93 Dupier Road, Ghent 518-929-0484
Family owned and operated Certified Organic maple sugaring operation producing high quality maple syrup from over 5,000 taps. Learn how maple syrup is crafted in a timber frame sugarhouse constructed with timber collected and milled on our land! Tours and complimentary samples of syrup, maple cotton candy, maple sugar and maple cream.
- E Jersey Meadow Farm** 104 Snyder Road, Ghent 518-249-7952
Family owned/operated small-scale, NYS certified raw milk dairy with a goal of quality and affordable milk. Enjoy free samples of milk and visit friendly Jersey cows and calves. Self-guided tours of the milking barn.
- F Little Ghent Farm** 282 Snyder Road, Ghent 518-392-0804
After two years of planning, clearing and building, using local architects and builders, our 75-acre family farm has been re-imagined and open for five years. Dedicated to bridging food, farming and community, Mimi, Richard and their team raise Animal Welfare Approved meat, chickens and laying hens alongside woodland raised pigs. *Made In Ghent* Farm Store sells eggs, meat, sourdough breads, focaccia and seasonal baked goods/prepared foods using products from the farm and local produce. Lunches/snacks to buy and eat or to take away.
- G Kinderhook Farm** 1958 County Route 21 (at the end of Garner Rd.), Ghent 518-929-3075
With fields and operations spanning Ghent and Chatham, visit the center of activity to learn more about raising grass-fed beef, lamb, pastured pork and chickens. A Farm Store offers beef, lamb, pork as well as raw honey, chicken and eggs for sale. Tours throughout the day.
- H The Berry Farm** 2304 State Route 203, Chatham 518-392-4609
Since 1982, a local, family-owned and operated farm and Farm Store, specializing in natural, organic and local produce/products as well as no-spray, pesticide-free greens/vegetables from their greenhouses throughout the year. Voted *Best Farm Market*, *Best Garden Center*, *Best Specialty Food Store* and Columbia County's *Best Farm*. *Locavore Award Winner!* The Cidery at the farm serves our own hard cider and local beers.
- I Staron's Farm Stand** 4 Merwin Road (at State Route 203), Chatham 518-392-2920
For 35 years, a family owned farm that grows a variety of fruits and vegetables and is the largest potato grower in the area. Farmstand open daily, June - October.
- J Equine Advocates Rescue & Sanctuary** 3212 State Route 66, Chatham 518-392-0175
Promotes the humane and responsible treatment of equines through rescue operations, advocacy work and education. 82 rescued horses, ponies, donkeys and mules reside at the sanctuary, which is a model for the way horses should live. Paddock graphics relate each animals story for an educational and fun experience!
- K Highland Farm** 395 Highland Road, Old Chatham 518-496-3435 www.highland-farm.com
Raises chickens, heritage breed turkeys and heritage breed pigs, which are pasture-raised and fed local organic grains. They also pasture Black Angus for Kinderhook Farm in the summer months. Farm Store sells pork, honey and maple syrup and takes pre-orders for pork and Thanksgiving turkeys. Tours from 10 am–4 pm.
- L Little Brook Farm** 548 County Route 13 (at Pitt Hall Road), Old Chatham 518-821-5506
One of the most diverse equine facilities in the nation. Established in 1977, Little Brook Farm has successfully combined equine rescue with educational programs, including riding instruction. Demos with hands-on activities and tours throughout the day.
- M Raven & Boar** 111 County Route 34, East Chatham 518-794-0125 www.ravenandboar.com
A family-owned farm with small herds of heritage breed pigs raised with care on open pasture and forest. Their Hudson Valley Charcuterie products include patés, rillettes, seasonal fresh sausages, bacon and pork cuts. Serving sausages and paté tastings from 12 noon–4 pm. Products available for purchase.
- N Dog Wood Farm & Rock City Mushrooms** 85 Hartigan Road, Old Chatham 518-821-4282
A diversified farm raising pastured chickens and turkeys, grass-fed beef, and indoor-cultivated mushrooms. Farm Store with fresh mushrooms, eggs, beef, and other farm foods, plus Thanksgiving turkey pre-orders. Tours throughout the day from 10 am to 3 pm.
- O Buttonwood Hollow Farm** 71 Loomis Road, Chatham 518-755-9143
A family farm focusing on regenerative agriculture. Offering rotationally grazed 100% grass-fed beef and pastured pork, real maple syrup, herbs, and cut flowers. Learn about pasture raised animals and see our sugar house. Farm Store open from 10 am–3 pm with beef, pork, eggs, maple syrup, cut flowers, granola and more. Tours at 11 am, 1 and 3 pm.
- P Red Rock Farm** 169 County Route 24, East Chatham 518-392-4813
A family farm raising grass-fed beef, dairy cattle, free roaming laying hens, and bountiful gardens. Self serve Farm Store with beef, eggs, and vegetables. Self-guided tours 10–4.
- Q Hawthorne Valley Farm** 327 County Route 21C, Ghent 518-672-7500
A 900-acre Demeter-certified Biodynamic® farm dedicated to producing high quality food for more than 35 years. Our farm includes dairy cows, vegetables, 300-plus member CSA, creamery, organic artisan bakery, fermentation enterprise and more! Farm Store has a full-line natural foods and groceries (open daily 7:30 am–7 pm) with a deli bar serving fresh organic meals. Guided farm tour at 11 am, or pick up a map for a self-guided tour.
- R High & Mighty Farm** 71 County Route 21C, Ghent 518-672-4202
High & Mighty Therapeutic Riding & Driving Center offers riding, driving and other equine assisted activities to children, teens and adults with special needs. Our herd also offers opportunities for individuals and groups to explore personal development, all in an integrated community setting. Tours from 10 am–3 pm.
- S The Barn at Miller's Crossing** 170 State Route 217, Hudson 518-851-2331
We grow certified organic vegetables, plants and flowers; raise a small grass-fed beef herd, make maple syrup and maple products and manage a 400-acre grain operation. Our produce is marketed through member CSAs, the Hudson Farmers' Market, our retail farmstand and numerous wholesale accounts. Our retail Farm Store, in a 250-yr-old Dutch Barn, is just around the corner from our home farm. Tours at the Farm Stand on Route 217 at 10 am, 11:30 am, and 1 pm.
